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COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of this course is to discuss the week's news in an informal matter as the weekend draws to a close. We will focus on key vocabulary and consider some related idioms...

- Reading articles followed by discussion and detailed reviewing of new lexis (often BBC 1min world news or trending items in Korea, often via Korea Times)
- News Videos followed by key vocab checkup.
- And/or a secondary more “fun” news story.
- Idioms will usually be based on a theme, e.g. colors, animals, etc
